A mandatory site visit will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, August 8, 2025, at the project site. All prospective bidders must attend in order to be eligible to submit a bid.

Section 2 – Instructions to Bidders

1. Submission of Bids

All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the project name:

George Conway Domestic Heat and Hot Water Replacement Project.

Bids must be received by 10:00 AM on Friday, August 15, 2025, at the Brick Housing Authority, 165 Chambers Bridge Road, Brick, NJ 08723. Late submissions will not be accepted.

2. Bid Opening

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the George Conway Community Room immediately following the submission deadline on Friday, August 15, 2025.

3. Bid Format

4. Bid Security

The Brick Housing Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive informalities, and award the contract in the best interest of the Authority.

7. Mandatory Site Visit

A mandatory site visit will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, August 8, 2025, at the Conway Building, 165 Chambers Bridge Road, Brick, NJ 08723. Bidders must attend this walkthrough to be eligible to submit a bid. The visit will include access to the mechanical room and existing boiler systems.

8. Contract Award

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, subject to approval by the Authority and compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

9. Equal Opportunity

Bidders must comply with all federal and state equal opportunity laws and regulations.

Section 3 – Scope of Work

Project Overview

The Brick Housing Authority is soliciting bids for the replacement of the domestic hot water and heating hot water systems at the George Conway Building, located at 165 Chambers Bridge Road, Brick, NJ. The existing systems are original to the building (1981) and are beyond their useful life.

Base Bid Scope

- Remove and dispose of the existing boiler modules, heat exchanger, and associated piping and flue components.
- Furnish and install:
 - Two (2) natural gas-fired condensing boilers (nominal 1,500 MBH each) for the heating hot water system.
 - Three (3) natural gas-fired condensing water heaters (minimum 300 MBH each) with integral storage tanks for domestic hot water.
 - Reuse of the existing 200-gallon storage tank for additional capacity.
- Provide new flue systems for both heating and domestic systems per manufacturer specifications.
- Install new base-mounted distribution pumps with VFDs for variable speed operation.
- Connect to existing domestic hot water recirculation system and building piping.
- Coordinate phasing to maintain domestic hot water service during construction.
- Provide all required testing, balancing, and commissioning of the new systems.

Alternate Bid #1 - Three-Boiler Redundancy Option

Provide pricing for an alternate configuration of three (3) natural gas-fired condensing boilers, each rated at approximately 1,000 MBH, in lieu of the two 1,500 MBH boilers specified in the base bid. This configuration is intended to provide N+1 redundancy for the heating hot water system.

Include all associated:

- Equipment
- Piping and valving
- Flue and venting systems
- Electrical and control modifications

Layout adjustments within the mechanical room

General Requirements

- All work must comply with applicable codes and standards, including but not limited to the International Mechanical Code, National Standard Plumbing Code, and local amendments.
- Contractor is responsible for all permits, inspections, and coordination with utility providers.
- Work must be scheduled during the cooling season to minimize disruption to residents.
- Contractor must submit a detailed phasing plan prior to mobilization.

Section 4 - General Conditions

1. Contract Documents

The contract documents shall include the Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, Scope of Work, Bid Form, General Conditions, Technical Specifications, Addenda (if any), and the executed Agreement.

2. Contractor Qualifications

The contractor must be licensed in the State of New Jersey and demonstrate experience with similar mechanical system replacements in occupied residential buildings.

3. Insurance Requirements

The contractor shall maintain the following insurance coverage throughout the duration of the project:

- General Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate
- Workers' Compensation: Statutory limits
- Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit Brick Housing Authority shall be named as an additional insured.

4. Performance and Payment Bonds

The successful bidder shall furnish performance and payment bonds, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price, within 10 days of contract award.

5. Project Schedule

Work shall commence within 10 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed and be substantially complete within 90 calendar days. A detailed construction schedule shall be submitted prior to mobilization.

6. Work Hours and Site Access

Work shall be performed during normal business hours unless otherwise approved. The contractor must coordinate access with the Authority and minimize disruption to residents.

7. Change Orders

All changes to the scope of work must be approved in writing by the Authority prior to execution. Unauthorized work will not be compensated.

8. Submittals

The contractor shall submit product data, shop drawings, and equipment specifications for review and approval prior to ordering materials.

9. Warranties

All equipment and workmanship shall be warranted for a minimum of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance. Manufacturer warranties shall be provided for all major components.

10. Final Acceptance and Closeout

Final payment will be issued upon completion of all punch list items, submission of closeout documents, and acceptance by the Authority.

11. Liquidated Damages

If the contractor fails to achieve substantial completion within the time specified, the Brick Housing Authority may assess liquidated damages in the amount of \$500 per calendar day until completion is achieved. This amount is intended to reasonably compensate the Authority for administrative and operational impacts due to delay.
